- If the researcher has changed the email address they use to log into their profile and no longer has access to it, the account
 information needs to be updated. If he/she remembers the password, he/she logs into his/her account and changes the email
 (pencil icon).If he/she does not remember the password, he/she should contact <u>Support ORCID</u>.
- Note: The ORCID iD remains with you throughout your professional career, regardless of the institution you are currently working
 in. If you change your place of employment, you can update your account with the new information and affiliation. The ORCID iD
 is a unique identifier of the author (scientist, academic, researcher) as a person, regardless of current or previous jobs or, where
 applicable, the overlap of multiple jobs. So definitely do not set up a new iD and use your existing one.4. Duplicitní ORCID/Scopus

- If you have a duplicate ORCID, you must keep one profile and cancel the other. Before cancelling a duplicate account, check with
 the library for OBD and RIV to see if you have already entered the identifier into OBD and sent it to RIV. To cancel a duplicate
 account, go to your primary profile in the Account settings Remove Duplicate Record. You will be prompted to enter the ORCID
 number of the profile you want to delete and the password for that profile.
- When the duplicate record is removed, the email address that is attached to it will be added to your primary ORCID, the duplicate record and all other information in the record will be removed.
