

## Dean's Decree No. 3/2025

### on the requirements of admission to study for the academic year 2025/2026

The Dean of the Faculty of Arts of the University of West Bohemia in Pilsen announces the admission procedure for the academic year 2025/2026 according to Section 48 et seq. of Act No. 111/1998 Coll., on Higher Education and on Amendments and Additions to Other Acts, to the following study programme:

#### Application deadline and payment of the administrative fee for the admission procedure:

Applications can only be submitted electronically at <http://eprihlaska.zcu.cz>.

The deadline for applications is **30 April 2025**.

The fee for each application is **CZK 600,-** due no later than **30 April 2025**.

When the application is submitted, the details for the payment of the admission fee are automatically generated. Each application is assigned a unique variable and specific symbol. If the fee is not paid within the specified deadline, the admission procedure will be terminated.

**Dates of entrance examinations:**

Entrance examinations for Bachelor and follow-up Master programmes will take place in the week of **9–13 June 2025**.

The alternate date of the entrance examination for Bachelor and follow-up Master programmes will take place in the week of **16–20 June 2025**.

The entrance examination for Doctoral programmes will take place during the week of **9–13 June 2025**.

**Invitations to the entrance examination:**

The Faculty sends invitations to the entrance examination only electronically to the applicant's e-mail. The date, venue and other relevant information will be published on the Faculty's website no later than three weeks before the date of the entrance examination.

**Conditions for admission:**

The Dean reserves the right to announce additional admission procedures for selected study programmes. Information about the announcement of the additional admission procedure and application deadlines will be published on the website of the Faculty of Arts no later than 2 May 2025.

**Admission requirements for the follow-up Master study programmes:**

**Admission to follow-up Master studies is conditional on** the completion of a Bachelor or Master study programme and passing the entrance exam.

Applicants must prove that they have completed their bachelor's or master's studies by uploading an officially certified copy of their diploma or the university's certificate of successful completion of the state final examination into the e-application form by **18 June 2025**.

An applicant will pass the entrance examination if his/her ranking number based on the score obtained in the entrance examination is lower than or equal to the number of applicants who are to be admitted to the programme. The number of admissions in the first and additional rounds shall be determined by the Admissions Board at its first meeting. The entrance examination for all study programmes shall take the form of a written test or an oral examination, or the combination of these, in accordance with the requirements set out below.

**Successful completion of a Bachelor's or Master's degree programme abroad**

If you have completed a university degree abroad, you must:

- Meet the conditions for the assessment of foreign education for the purposes of the admission procedure in accordance with Rector's Directive No. 34R/2017

and provide the documents prescribed therein; or

- submit the original or an officially certified copy of the nostrification or an equivalent form resulting from the concluded and valid international treaties of the Czech Republic on mutual recognition of education.

**Study programme of Anthropological Studies:**

The entrance examination takes the form of a written test of general knowledge of social and cultural anthropology and of sub-disciplines according to the individual specialisations (cultural theory and applied anthropology / biological and ecological anthropology / Middle Eastern and African realities) within the scope of the Bachelor degree. The test also includes supplementary questions in social sciences and humanities, Czech and world literature, art history and international relations.

This Decree shall enter into force and effect on 3 February 2025.
